- Contact would need to be made with school if your child <u>is</u> staying at home.
- Any parents willing to bring their child in to school and assist with supervision would be greatly appreciated.
- In order to get the school functioning as quickly and as normal as possible, help to clear paths and the playground would be essential. Any volunteers greatly appreciated.
