

HOOK CORONATION CELEBRATIONS

Hook Parish Council invites you to:

- Decorate your homes and gardens with flags, bunting and even lights. (We will put up decorations on the Memorial Hall, Playpark entrance and a hired marquee) Kids make the crowns we invited them to make in a school assembly. Villagers bake cakes / buns with a coronation theme.
- **On Saturday 6th May** watch the coronation of Charles III on the big screen at Heppy's if you haven't a TV. Make a noise on your doorsteps with bells, pans etc at the point when London church bells ring out at the end of the Westminster Abbey ceremony. (Hook Church bells will ring too, so listen out and join in.)
- Between 2 and 4 in the afternoon deliver children's crowns to the memorial hall for later judging (labelled with names and ages of the makers) Celebration cakes and buns can also be dropped off there at this time.
- **On Sunday 7th May** bring a picnic to the Playpark at midday and celebrate the occasion with a Village Fayre . There will be :
 - A coronation procession from the Memorial Hall to the Playpark (Kids pick up your crowns at 11.45 from the Memorial Hall) ready for the procession. Costumes would be lovely !)
 - A DJ will announce who has been judged the King and Queen of Hook, and they will be crowned in the marquee.
 - There will be an ice cream van, bouncy castle, tugs of war in age- related groups, apple-bobbing, three legged-races and lots of other traditional village games. All games will be free to join in and commemorative coins will be given to individual winners. There will be a distribution of pieces of a large celebration cake and the cakes/ buns donated by villagers before raising 3 Cheers for the King !
